



## STATE COORDINATOR OF REFEREES (ASSOCIATION CROQUET)

### JOB DESCRIPTION

The State Coordinators of Referees for Association Croquet (SCR-AC) for Croquet Victoria has overall responsibility for the coordination of all relevant aspects of refereeing within Victoria.

#### **Supervision**

The SCR AC is an appointee of the Council of Croquet Victoria and reports regularly to that body's Committee of Management, through the Secretary. Reports are to include details of activities and expenditure.

#### **Requisites**

It is preferable that the SCR-AC is an accredited Association Croquet referee and active at state level tournaments, however persons who recently met these criteria can fill the role.

#### **Duties**

The duties of the SCR-AC include the following, as appropriate:

- Representing Croquet Victoria on the Croquet Australia Referees Committee;
- Co-chairing the Croquet Victoria Referee and Laws Committee
- Coordinating the training, accreditation and reaccreditation of AC referees within Victoria;
- Appointing sufficient Tutor and Examining Referees and overseeing their performance;
- Coordinating the running of AC Referee Refresher Days throughout Victoria on an annual basis;
- Maintaining a list of accredited AC referees within Victoria;
- Acting as, or appointing, Tournament Referee for all Croquet Victoria AC events;
- Providing interpretations of, or rulings on, the Laws as required;
- Providing a budget for the following years activities to the Treasurer for inclusion in the Croquet Victoria annual budget;
- Other activities as directed
