



SELECTION COMMITTEES

JOB DESCRIPTION

Appointment & Duration

The Committees are appointed by the Council of Croquet Victoria at its meeting immediately following the Annual General Meeting, and nominations for appointment shall be accompanied by a statement outlining the nominee's experience and capability to undertake the role of selector.

Each Committee will consist of up to five members plus the VCA President or his/her delegate (who shall be a VCA Director) as an ex-officio member.

In the event that there are less than five nominations for a committee, the committee may invite suitably qualified persons for Council appointment to bring the committee membership to five. However, if there are less than three nominations, Council shall appoint suitable qualified persons to the committee.

Committee members serve for one year, until the next AGM

Qualifications for Committee Membership

A member preferably needs to be an experienced croquet player, not necessarily active, but familiar with the standard of play for national and invitational events and who will attend medal events, important VCA fixtures and if possible some country events.

Meetings & Reporting

The Committees meet as necessary to fulfill their responsibilities and supplies a copy of the minutes of each meeting, and supporting papers, to the VCA Secretary. They provide a report for inclusion in the VCA Annual Report and report to the Committee of Management as required.

Objectives of the Selection Committees

- To provide opportunities for competitive play and to improve the standard of croquet in players of all levels.
- To select players and reserves from within Victoria to play in the various squads and tournaments run by the VCA as listed in the annexes.
- To select players to represent Victoria in interstate team competitions, the Eire Cup for Association Croquet and the WCF Shield for Golf Croquet.
