### Victorian AC Women's and Men's Championships

The Women's and Men's Championships were held at Cairnlea in unsettled Melbourne Spring weather on the weekend of 26-27 October. The courts were in good condition and reasonably quick with some Spring growth evident.

The **Women's Championships** had 7 competitors playing a round robin in a single block. The Championship was won by **Gail Hopkins, Essendon** (5 wins, 61 net hoops) from Tricia Devlin, Castlemaine (5 wins, 56 net hoops). Gail beat Elaine Coverdale, Essendon in the last round to win the Championship and put Elaine in 3<sup>rd</sup> place with 4 wins and 44 net hoops.

There were 11 competitors in the **Men's Championships**. The format was two blocks playing a round robin with the top two players in each block playing a single game semi-final and final.

Stephen Forster, Belmont (5 wins, 65 net hoops) won block A from Kevin Maloney, Bright (4 wins, 31 net hoops). Simon Watkins was 3<sup>rd</sup> in block A with 3 wins and -9 net hoops.

Kevin Beard, Yarrowonga (4 wins, 28 net hoops) won block B from William Hadden, Brunswick (3 wins, 7 net hoops) with Chris Grant, Ringwood (2 wins, 21 net hoops) in 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

Stephen Forster won his semi-final against William Hadden 26TP-2 and Kevin Beard beat Kevin Maloney 26-2 in the other semi. The final was won by **Stephen Forster** over Kevin Beard 26-12. William Hadden won the playoff for 3<sup>rd</sup> place against Kevin Maloney 23-18.

The past month has been a busy one for VCC with the Croquet Victoria AC Divisional Championships, the State Squad Doubles, the AC Men's & Women's Championships; as well as the Croquet Australia AC President's Eights, AC Open Doubles & Singles Championships; with the Gateball Championships at the end of November/start of December and the Croquet Victoria GC Handicap Doubles & Singles and AC Open Doubles & Singles Championships to be played during December.

Last month was also a busy one for me with attendance at the bi-monthly Council meeting, and at several sub-committee or working group meetings (by virtue of my *ex-officio* membership of all committees and working groups). I also took the opportunity of a Vicsport organised course to renew my MPIO qualifications.

By the time that you are reading this, I will have also represented Croquet Victoria at the Vicsport Annual General Meeting.

I am pleased to report that Council has confirmed Ian Petersen (Belmont CC) as the new State Coordinator of Golf Croquet and Hetty Veldman (Castlemaine CC) as its Complaints Officer and wish them well in their appointments. However, we still need a Coordinator of Association Croquet to promote and re-invigorate AC within the state.

Wyndham City Council is gathering community reaction and comments on their *Sport Facility User Guide 2020-2025* with the Western Metropolitan Croquet & Malletsports Association participating on behalf of Croquet Victoria, as the City of Wyndham falls within its boundaries.

Elsewhere in this edition of *Malletsports Victoria* is an article concerning the WCF AC World Championship to be held at VCC, Belmont, Essendon, Williamstown and possibly Alexandra Ballarat clubs in February next year. When we held the GC World Championship in 2017, many AC players volunteered their time to support the event, now is the time when GC players can return the favour. Please contact me or one of the clubs direct if you can help for even a single day.

### VCC

**VCC Maintenance:** Painting of the fascia has been completed and the new 'Victorian Croquet Centre' lettering has been ordered. Quotes are being sourced to clear out the guttering.

**Removal of Trees and Garden Beds:** It is proving extremely difficult to engage a contractor to undertake this work. Two consulting firms recommended the removal of gardens and trees surrounding the Victorian Croquet Centre as a step to ensure that water drains away from the building foundation.

### VCA:

**Croquet Victoria Strategic Plan 2021-2025:** The draft vision and goals for our next Strategic Plan have been distributed to clubs for comment on 27 October 2019 in the first round of consultation. As the Strategic Plan takes shape, drafts will be published on the Planning for Croquet page in the Resources section of the Croquet Victoria website. <https://croquetvic.asn.au/displaypage.php?ref=Planning%20for%20Croquet>

**Strategic Plan Implementation Sub-Committee:** Kate Patrick and Sarina Ceva-al-Hewitt were elected to this Sub-Committee at the October Council Meeting. The Terms of Reference allow for up to five members and efforts are underway to co-opt additional members to be approved at a future Council meeting.

**Croquet Victoria Officer Vacancies:** Ian Petersen has been endorsed as the State Coordinator of Golf Croquet and Hetty Veldman as the Complaint Officer. No nomination has been received for the State Coordinator of Association Croquet position.

**Review of Croquet Victoria Policies:** The following policy is currently being reviewed:

Provision of Liquor and Catering at VCC Policy

A list of policies and job descriptions for review in 2020 is being prepared,

**Seniors Festival 2019:** Thank you to those clubs who have provided reports and photos of 'Come & Try' croquet days during October. These have been posted to Facebook and will be included in the 2020 Annual Report.

**Active April 2020:** The process for engagement with Active April has changed. Active April have changed the 2019 'My Local' tab in the Active April website to 'My Offers'. The registration system opens to the public after Australia Day so details of the involvement of any of our clubs needs to be returned to the organisers by the end of this year.

**Athlete Travel Pathways Grant Program:** two applications have been submitted under this program. One to support the Eire Cup Team (\$6,000.00) and one to support the Victorian representative to the Croquet Australia Association Croquet Gold Medal (\$1,250.00).

**Special General Meeting 16 December 2019:** The Notice of Special General Meeting was forwarded to Regional Secretaries on 7 November 2019.

**Committee of Management Positions up for Election AGM 2020:** The position of Croquet Victoria Secretary is up for election at the Annual General Meeting on Monday 15 June 2020. ### **Rich River Golf Croquet Open Singles Tournament**

The Rich River Golf Croquet Open Singles Tournament was run on Saturday 12th October to Monday 14th October with players from around NSW and Victoria competing in divisions based on handicaps.

On Saturday competitors in the -2 to 4 handicap range competed in a closely fought battle in which the top three places depended on the last game. Owen Dickinson of Essendon and Richard Parks of Monash were tied on wins and hoops as they went into the final game.

Owen won the game and the tournament, showing the form which earned him the Australian GC Champion title earlier this month. Runner up was Rich River's Russ Smyth who nudged Richard into third place with a nett hoop score of +10 to Richard's +5.

On Sunday players with the handicap range 5 to 8 completed in friendly but highly competitive play. Played in 2 blocks, block winners Rhonda Smith of Lakes Entrance and Bev Floyd of Rich River played off in the final. Winning the toss and getting a perfect shot down to hoop 1 got Bev off to a good start. But Rhonda played a great game with accurate roquets and hoop shots and it was anyone's game to the end when Bev won 7-5.

On Monday the competition was for players with the 9 to 12 handicaps. Again played in 2 blocks, block winners Peter Whittakers from Deniliquin and Sandra Retallick of Rich River played off in the final. The win went to Peter who beat Sandra 7-4 in a well played final.

### **17<sup>th</sup> WCF AC World Championship**

The WCF AC World Championship will be held at the Victorian Croquet Centre (VCC), and at satellite venues, Belmont, Essendon and Williamstown Croquet Clubs from 15<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2020. There may also be a day's play at Ballarat Alexandra Croquet Club during the Plate competition, depending on how many players who do not reach the Knockout stage decide to continue playing.

Prior to the event there will also be a Qualifying Tournament for those who were not awarded Ranking or Member Places or a Wild Card, from 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> February 2020 from which four players will advance to the World Championship. This event will be at VCC only.

This is an opportunity to see the world's best AC players with contestants from Australia, Canada, England, Japan (1), Latvia (1), New Zealand, Scotland, South Africa, Spain, USA and Wales. Spectators are welcome at all venues, but it may be wise to contact the venue beforehand if you are considering a large party visiting. Also be aware that catering for spectators may be restricted or unavailable at some venues (refer to the Catering page on the event website (see below for link or go to the Home page of the Croquet Victoria website for a link).

Details of the competitions, players and other pertinent information is on the event website [2020-acworlds.croquetvic.asn.au](http://2020-acworlds.croquetvic.asn.au) which will be updated on a daily basis during the events.

Organizing and running an event of this size (20 players in the Qualifier and 80 in the world championship) takes time and manpower. Volunteers are always needed and now is the time for GC players to put up their hands as AC players did during the 2017 WCF GC World Championship.

In particular there is a need for:

- Hoop setters at all venues (training will be provided if necessary);
- Driver/s of a minibus from VCC to Belmont (Geelong) and return each day during the World Championship; this can be a different driver on different days and requires only a car license;
- Possibly transport of players between VCC and Essendon or Williamstown in private vehicles – the requirement would be known the evening before;
- Someone to manage sale of merchandise at VCC;
- People to help with kitchen and bar duties at VCC –there will be a caterer but there will be a need to collect and put cups, plates, etc., through the dishwasher.
