



Coaching Policy

INTRODUCTION

Croquet Victoria is responsible for the training and accreditation of coaches and for the provision of coaching to affiliated clubs and individual members. This policy details how this is to be carried out.

POLICY

Croquet Victoria Council is to appoint a State Coordinator of Coaching. If circumstances require it, separate State Coordinators of Coaching may be appointed for different codes of malletsports.

The State Coordinator/s of Coaching are responsible for:

- liaising with the Croquet Australia appointed National Coordinator/s of Coaching;
- in concert with the Croquet Australia Coaching Committee, implementing the Croquet Australia approved coach training and accreditation program;
- satisfying requirements for accredited coaches within Croquet Victoria;
- encouraging the further development of coaches eg, for example via networking and mentoring; and
- ensuring that requests for coaching at affiliated clubs or of groups of individual members are met within a reasonable time.

Coaches will be accredited in accordance with Croquet Australia programs in force from time to time. The aim is to have coaches of the appropriate level and endorsements, in each Region and preferably within each affiliated club.

Croquet Victoria and its accredited coaches will make no charge for the training and accreditation of coaches.

Accredited coaches may charge for the provision of coaching to clubs and individual members, such charge to be by agreement between the coach and members involved.
