



## REFEREES COMMITTEE

### JOB DESCRIPTION

#### **Appointment & Duration**

The Committee is appointed by the Council of Croquet Victoria at its meeting immediately following the Annual General Meeting, from members nominated by Regions or Clubs. Committee members serve for one year, until the next AGM

#### **Qualifications for Committee Membership**

To be a member of the Referees Committee, a member needs to be an experienced referee, either AC or GC.

#### **Meetings & Reporting**

The Committee, which is chaired by the State Coordinator/s of Referees, meets as necessary to fulfill its responsibilities and supplies a copy of the minutes of each meeting, and supporting papers, to the VCA Secretary. It provides a report for inclusion in the VCA Annual Report and reports to the Committee of Management as required.

#### **Duties**

The duties of the Committee include the following, as appropriate:

- Assist the State Coordinator(s) of Refereeing in his/her duties
- Promote the role of referees throughout Victoria
- Be a venue for discussion on refereeing matters
