



STATE COORDINATOR UNDER 21 CROQUET

PURPOSE

The State Coordinator Under 21 Croquet is to create and deliver a state program aimed at people under the age of 21 that will encourage, nurture and develop players in the sport of Croquet.

SUPERVISION

The State Coordinator Under 21 Croquet is an appointee of the Council of Croquet Victoria and reports regularly to that body's Committee of Management, through the Secretary. Reports are to include details of activities and expenditure.

DUTIES

- To develop croquet programs aimed at players under 21 years of age.
- To co-ordinate the delivery of the programs across Victoria
- To work with accredited coaches to ensure consistency in the delivery of the program
- Provide a working plan and budget for consideration by the Council at its December meeting for implementation the following year.
- Take a lead role in the development of an Under 21 Squad in the lead up to any national or international event
- To represent Croquet Victoria at meetings convened by Croquet Australia's National Coordinator of U21 Croquet
- To coordinate with equivalent appointed officers of the other State Associations, as appropriate.

COMPLIANCE

The position must take account of relevant legislation (national and state - including Victoria's Child Safety standards) and policy (Croquet Australia and Croquet Victoria).

REPORTING

- Minutes of any meetings convened are to be forwarded to the Secretary within seven (7) working days.
- An annual report to be submitted for inclusion in the Croquet Victoria Annual Report.

TERMS

The position is appointed annually by Council at the meeting following the AGM and is for one year
