All players will be expected to assist with setting-up the courts prior to 9.40am and packing up at the end of the day.

Games will be played according to the points below. Otherwise, under WCF Golf Croquet Rules and Regulations for Tournaments. 13 Point games (first to 7). Handicap range: -6 to 16. Three sections, determined according to entries. Level play. Games timed at 55 minutes. Balls will be Dawson International and games may be double banked. Players may be their own referees. If possible, wear whites or club colors. **Handicap cards will not be used.**

The Tournament Manager reserves the right to vary the terms of any event or entry.

Players with surnames starting A - K inclusive, are asked to bring a plate of afternoon tea to share.
