Event 2 – Handicap Range 7 to 11 Block Draw – Advanced Level - Dawson International Balls

Events are planned in the handicap ranges shown but may be varied depending on entries. A larger number of entries may also require some play to be arranged on Thursday 28th February or in the evening under court lighting.

Entries Close Friday 22nd February 6 p.m. Entrants notified of details of the first game.

Entries - by mail, email or phone to the Tournament Manager, stating name, club handicap and contact phone number. Fees may be included or paid at the time of the player's first match.

Play will commence at 9.30 a.m. weekdays and 8 a.m. Saturdays and Sundays.

Players are responsible for playing to the correct handicap. Handicap Cards are to be verified 15 minutes before the first game. Players should be present at least 30 minutes prior to the start of their match as games may start earlier if possible.

Conditions – The Tournament will be played in accordance with the Laws of Association Croquet and Australian Regulations. Hoops will be set at 3 11/16 inches (+ or - 1/32 in) Members of Affiliated Clubs and Associations are eligible to enter. Recognised croquet attire is to be worn. Double balls may be used except in finals.

Time Limits – Regulation 16.3.1 will apply. Handicap 2 -11 Duration 2 ¼ hours (+1/4 hour if double banked.)

Protections - Please state at entry any required protection.

No Protection for weekend players who may be required to play three matches per day. Players drawn to play a weekend player may possibly have to play three matches per day.

The Tournament Manager reserves the right to refuse any entry, cancel any event, or to combine any two events, if insufficient entries are received.

Refreshments - Morning and afternoon tea provided. A light lunch will also be available for purchase by players unable to bring lunch.
