## **Golf Croquet Conditions of Play, Noosa 2026**

- The Tournament Manager reserves the right to add, cancel or alter events owing to the number of entrants, weather or other unforeseen changes in conditions.
- The tournament will be played under the current ACA Rules of Golf Croquet.
- Hoops will be set at  $3\frac{11}{16}$  inches  $\pm \frac{1}{32}$  inch.
- All players must present their handicap cards to the Tournament Manager by 8am.
- All games will commence at 8.30am, with a briefing at 8.15am. Courts will be available for practice from 7.45am.
- Players are entitled to a 5-minute warm up before the designated time for their first game of the day.
- Competition format will consist of a combination of Round Robin and Knockout matches depending on number of entries. (Seeding will be based on handicaps and indexes as on closing date for entry.)
- Games will be level play and may be double-banked depending on the number of entries.
- All events will have 13-point games with a maximum 45 minutes playing time. After the bell, the game ends when the moving ball comes to rest. If the scores are level, play continues until the next point is scored.
- Time clocks will be used. They may be stopped while waiting for a referee to arrive, and when a double-banked game is held up by the other game.
- Referees will be supervising referees. Should there be insufficient qualified referees, knowledgeable players may be available to be on call.
- Players must notify the Tournament Manager before leaving the venue during the day's play.
- In the case of rain or extreme heat, the Tournament Manager will decide if play is to continue.
