Albury Croquet Club's recipient of the Croquet Victoria Heritage Badge was Brenda Bruhn who has been playing croquet for 14 plus years.

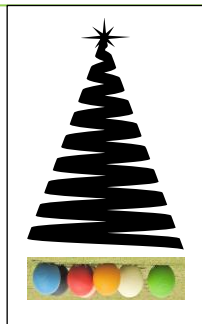
